

RESOLUTION 2286-24

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WINTER PARK, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE COORDINATION BETWEEN THE CITY OF WINTER PARK AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION REGARDING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A NEW TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT THE INTERSECTION OF S.R. 426/ALOMA AVENUE AND CORTLAND AVENUE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Winter Park desires to install a traffic signal at the intersection of S.R. 426/Aloma Avenue and Cortland Avenue;

WHEREAS, the City of Winter Park acknowledges the S.R. 426/Aloma Avenue corridor is over capacity, and the new traffic signal should not reduce congestion or delay;

WHEREAS, the City of Winter Park acknowledges that benefits to network access and connectivity are no less important than traffic capacity consideration;

WHEREAS, the City of Winter Park acknowledges that the proposed traffic signal will enhance the mobility options for bicycle and pedestrian safety and connectivity by creating safer access for all residents generally, and specifically to neighboring local parks and facilities;

WHEREAS, the City of Winter Park acknowledges that challenges to placement of the signal would require mitigation strategies between the City and appropriate parties to ensure safe operations and constructability;

WHEREAS, the City of Winter Park acknowledges the acquisition of any required permits, rights-of-way, and related costs associated with the installation and procurement of the proposed traffic signal will be the responsibility of the City;

WHEREAS, the City of Winter Park would accept maintenance of the proposed traffic signal and related equipment under the Florida Department of Transportation's Traffic Signal Maintenance and Compensation Agreement;

WHEREAS, the City of Winter Park acknowledges that timing of the traffic signal installation is of the essence, and shall install the proposed traffic signal in advance of the letting conducted by the Florida Department of Transportation's S.R. 426 Resurfacing, Restoration, and Rehabilitation project, which is currently scheduled for August 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Commission of the City of Winter Park, Florida that:

SECTION 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Resolution.

SECTION 2. Acceptance. The City Manager is hereby given authority on behalf of the City of Winter Park to take steps needed to carry out the goals as set forth in the recitals, including the acceptance of maintenance of the proposed traffic signal

and related equipment under the Florida Department of Transportation's Traffic Signal Maintenance and Compensation Agreement.

SECTION 3. Effective date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption of this Resolution by the City Commission of the City of Winter Park, Florida.
