



Since January 20, the Park Avenue Refresh project team has been busy completing the air spading of all the tree wells and installing irrigation conduit at the north end of the avenue. The additional parking spaces on Morse Boulevard between New York and Virginia Avenues are now open and available for public parking.



Crews will continue working on the Phase 1 construction activities described below.

DATES: February 16 through February 27

LOCATIONS: Between Swoope and Garfield avenues, work has already started along the west side of Park Avenue and will continue along the east side as tasks are completed.

PHASE 1 CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES:

There are 22 locations where crews are demolishing concrete panels in preparation for the installation of the new streetlight poles. This early morning work involves the use of a wet saw, small jackhammer and manual removal of the concrete.



Barricades are placed around each location to offer project information and ensure safety around the site.



The city's Water & Wastewater Department's vac-con truck will assist with the excavation of dirt to prepare the ground for the installation of the streetlight pole concrete bases. This work will be performed in the early morning hours.

Also during early morning hours, crews are expected to pour the concrete bases at each of the 22 streetlight pole locations.

Beginning in March, crews will use the directional bore machine (pictured left) to pull electric, fiber and irrigation conduit (pictured right) from streetlight base to streetlight base. This work will be performed during the day in preparation for the installation of the new streetlight poles.



Upon completion of the directional boring work, the closures of one to two blocks at a time will begin.
