



Park Avenue *refresh*

City of Winter Park project updates

During the month of March, as part of Phase 1 between Swoope and Garfield avenues, the Park Avenue Refresh project team completed the following:

Installation and pouring of the concrete bases at all locations for the 24 new Phase 1 streetlight poles.



Directional boring and pulling of conduit for new irrigation, electric, fiber and low-voltage to each pole location.

DIRECTIONAL BORING CONTINUES AND ELECTRIC VAULTS & FIBER BOXES TO BE INSTALLED

Beginning the week of April 6:

- Completion of the last sections of directional boring and pulling of conduit at the following locations:
 - South of St. Margaret Mary Church to Boca
 - Garfield Avenue
 - Canton Avenue between the Charles Hosmer Morse Museum & Panera Bread
- Demolition of additional sidewalk panels to install electrical and fiber vaults and boxes to service new streetlight poles.
 - Expect some disruption to pedestrian traffic in select locations.
 - Areas around the vaults and boxes will be temporarily filled with cold patch asphalt until new concrete is poured.

COMING UP NEXT: BLOCK-BY-BLOCK CLOSURES (Swoope to Canton avenues)

Beginning the week of April 13 for approximately four weeks:

- Block-by-Block closure between Swoope Avenue to Canton Avenue
 - This involves the complete closure of the right of way, parallel parking spots adjacent to the curb, and the one southbound lane of traffic.
 - Detour signage will be placed directing vehicular traffic around the closure.
 - Pedestrian access to the businesses will be maintained during the construction.
- Activity inside the Block-by-Block barricades will include:
 - Removal and repair of 80% of right of way sidewalk
 - Construction of bump-outs at major intersections (Cole & Canton)
 - Repair and treatments of raised planters
 - Installation of safety bollards at intersections
 - Placement of new decorative planter pots
 - Replacement of trash cans and recycling receptacles
 - Removal of non-contributing signs
 - Installation of new streetlight poles
 - Customers and guests to the avenue will see two street light poles (old and new) placed within close proximity to one another during the construction.
 - The old poles will remain energized to provide continuous lighting along Park Avenue and are planned to be removed once all 24 new streetlight poles of Phase 1 are installed and energized.
- Once the construction activity within the block is completed, the crews will continue work on the west side of Park Avenue and mobilize to the next block (Canton to Garfield avenues).
- Additional parking has been provided at West Morse Boulevard between New York and Virginia avenues.
