This week, the Park Avenue Refresh team started the Block-by-Block closures from Swoope to Canton avenues. This first block will be *closed for approximately four weeks*.

**Block-by-Block closure between Swoope Avenue to Canton Avenue:**

- Please allow additional time while travelling through this area. This is an active construction zone, so please abide by the closures to maintain safety in this area.
- This involves the complete closure of the right of way, parallel parking spots adjacent to the curb, and the one southbound lane of traffic.
- This approach allows crews to focus their project work in smaller sections, helping improve efficiency while minimizing the overall disruption of construction.
- Detour signs have been placed directing vehicular traffic around the closure.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained to ensure residents and guests can continue to shop, dine and access businesses throughout the project area.



**Activity inside the Block-by-Block barricades will include:**

- Removal and repair of a majority of the right of way sidewalk
- Construction of bump-outs at major intersections (Cole & Canton avenues)
- Repair and treatments of raised planters
- Installation of safety bollards at intersections
- Placement of new decorative planter pots
- Replacement of trash cans and recycling receptacles
- Removal of non-contributing signs



- Installation of new streetlight poles
- Customers and guests to the avenue will see two street light poles (old and new) placed within close proximity to one another during the construction.
- The old poles will remain energized to provide continuous lighting along Park Avenue and are planned to be removed once all 24 new streetlight poles of Phase 1 are installed and energized.
- Once the construction activity within the block is completed, the crews will continue work on the west side of Park Avenue and head south, mobilizing to the next block (Canton to Garfield avenues).
- Additional parking has been provided at West Morse Boulevard between New York and Virginia avenues.
