In April, the Park Avenue Refresh team started Phase 1's Block-by-Block closures from Swoope to Canton avenues. As work continues on the Park Avenue Refresh Project, we wanted to provide an update on upcoming construction activities and anticipated timelines along Park Avenue.

Swoope to Cole avenues:

- Concrete pours are scheduled for the **week of May 11**, and the roadway will reopen by the end of that same week.
- New decorative light poles will also be installed by the end of May.
 - Customers and guests to the avenue will see two street light poles (old and new) placed within close proximity to one another during the construction.
 - The old poles will remain energized to provide continuous lighting along Park Avenue and are planned to be removed once all 24 new streetlight poles of Phase 1 are installed and energized.



Cole to Canton avenues:

- Concrete pours are scheduled for the **week of May 18**, and the roadway will reopen by the end of that same week.
- Raised planter bed reconstruction will continue along the west side of the Charles Hosmer Morse Museum of American Art. Parking within this block will **remain closed** during this planter work through the **beginning of June**.



Canton to Garfield avenues:

- The west side of Park Avenue in this block will close for approximately one month beginning the **week of May 18** as construction continues moving south along Park Avenue.

Following completion of the Canton to Garfield avenues block-by-block closure, construction activities will move north to the east side of Park Avenue between Swoope and Canton avenues. Additional parking is available on Morse Boulevard between New York and Virginia avenues.

While you may see temporary closures in active construction zones, Park Avenue and its **businesses remain open** for shopping, dining, and strolling. Our incredible local **merchants, museums & restaurants are open, accessible & ready to welcome you.**
