City of Winter Park project updates

June 5, 2026

As work continues to progress within the Canton Avenue to Garfield Avenue block closure, we wanted to provide an update on upcoming construction activities and anticipated timelines along Park Avenue.

Swoope to Cole avenues:

- The street and parking within this block are open and the finishing touches of planter pots with seasonal plantings and landscaping around tree wells are coming soon.



Cole to Canton avenues:

- Raised planter bed reconstruction continues along the west side of Park Avenue, closest to The Charles Hosmer Morse Museum of American Art. Parking within this block will **remain closed** through the **end of June** as raised planter bed brick work continues.



Canton to Garfield avenues:

Since construction began in this block, crews have removed sections of sidewalk to prepare for infrastructure improvements and started, and will continue, the demolition of raised planter beds. New irrigation lines have also been installed, laying the groundwork for future landscaping enhancements that will help support the long-term health and beauty of Park Avenue's streetscape. The west side of Park Avenue in this block will **reopen the week of June 15** (parking will remain closed).



Following completion of the Canton to Garfield avenues block-by-block closure, construction activities will move north to the east side of Park Avenue between Swoope and Canton avenues. Additional parking is available on Morse Boulevard between New York and Virginia avenues.

While you may see temporary closures in active construction zones, Park Avenue and its **businesses remain open** for shopping, dining, and strolling. Our incredible local **merchants, museums & restaurants are open, accessible & ready to welcome you.**
