Why are there two streetlight poles side-by-side on Park Avenue? 💡



As part of the Park Avenue Refresh Project, new smart streetlight poles are being installed throughout Phase 1. Earlier this week our Electric Utility linemen and Horizon Utility Services (HDD) are in the process of installing 12 new poles from Swoope to Garfield avenues. These new poles will have the capability to house Wi-Fi routers, security cameras, audio, hanging flower baskets and street banners. They will also be smart lights, meaning our Electric Utility Department can track them from anywhere in the city and be notified remotely if an individual or group of lights are flickering, dim or out completely.

This temporary overlap allows crews to maintain consistent lighting throughout the project while transitioning to the upgraded infrastructure, keeping Park Avenue safe, accessible & illuminated throughout construction. To ensure Park Avenue remains well-lit and safe for pedestrians and vehicular traffic during construction, the existing streetlight poles will remain in place until all the new poles in Phase 1 are fully energized and operational.
