Holiday Weekend Park Avenue Refresh Updates

As we head into Independence Day weekend, here are the most recent updates as it relates to the [Park Avenue Refresh Project](#).

Swoope to Canton avenues

The raised planter bed reconstruction continues along the west side of Park Avenue, closest to the Charles Hosmer Morse Museum of American Art. A majority of the parking in front of the museum is available with the exception of a few spaces closest to the planters remaining closed through mid-July.



Canton to Garfield avenues

A majority of the work in this block has been completed. Crews have repoured sections of sidewalk and curbs, completed the new bump-outs at the Canton intersection and the new light poles have been installed. The demolition, repair and reconstruction of raised planter beds will continue through the **end of July**. New irrigation lines have also been installed, laying the groundwork for future landscaping enhancements that will help support the long-term health and beauty of Park Avenue's streetscape.



Upcoming Block-by-Block Closures

Following the Canton to Garfield avenues block-by-block closure, construction activities will move north to the east side of Park Avenue between Swoope and Canton avenues. Swoope to Cole avenues will be closed starting Monday, July 6 and will extend to Canton Avenue the afternoon of Wednesday, July 8.

This involves the closure of the one northbound lane, parallel parking and right of way for approximately 4 weeks (weather permitting).

Additional parking is available on Morse Boulevard between New York and Virginia avenues.

Fourth of July on Park Avenue

Construction crews are securing and tidying up all active work areas in advance of the Fourth of July holiday weekend so residents and guests can safely enjoy everything Park Avenue has to offer.

As you celebrate Independence Day in Winter Park, we encourage you to shop, dine and support the local businesses that continue to welcome customers throughout construction. Restaurants, museums and businesses remain open, and your support helps keep Park Avenue vibrant while these improvements take shape.
