PARKS & RECREATION UPDATES

as of Thursday, November 10, 2022

- All indoor recreation facilities will resume normal operating hours Friday, November 11.
- Athletic fields at Martin Luther King, Jr. Park, Ward Park, and Cady Way
 - Opening will be determined by mid-afternoon Friday, November 11.
- Cady Way Park Tennis and Pickleball Courts
 - Open Friday, November 11, however, lights are non-functional.
 - Lights are expected to be resolved by Friday evening, but will close at 5 p.m., if not resolved.
- Dinky Dock Boat Launch
 - Closed until high water levels recede.
 - Expected to resume normal operating hours Monday, November 14.
- Lake Baldwin Park and off-leash dog area
 - Closed with the expectation to resume normal operating hours Monday, November 14.
- Winter Park Pines Golf Course and Winter Park Golf Course
 - Open for walking only Friday, November 11 at noon.
- Winter Park Tennis Center
 - Open Friday, November 11.
 - Confirm court conditions at [407-599-3445](tel:407-599-3445) if you have an existing reservation on the morning of Friday, November 11. Early morning court reservations on clay courts could be impacted.
- All other city parks will resume normal operating hours Friday, November 11.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- While Tropical Storm Nicole did not result in major damage at the parks, there is still a considerable amount of debris in some areas.
- Please use good judgement while enjoying the parks and do not interfere with city employees and equipment that may be performing post-storm clean-up efforts.
