### Winter Park

### Students jailed in drug sweep

Students from Rollins College and the University of Central Florida spent Monday night in jail after undercover agents busted a man suspected of drug-dealing and then people looking for pot, police said. Keith Prusak, 25, was arrested on charges of selling 1 pound of marijuana to a drug agent, records state. Officers then set up shop at the house on Northwood Boulevard, near Baldwin Park, after arresting four or five occupants, Officer Jim Whitman said. All together, police seized 3 pounds of marijuana, 4 ounces of hallucinogenic mushrooms, 14 grams of cocaine, two pistols and \$12,840 in cash. Five of the eight suspects identified themselves as students. One student, Cory Fritch, 22, of Winter Park, was charged with felony possession of cocaine and marijuana after agents sold him pot, then discovered he had almost a half-ounce of cocaine, records show.
