To mark this milestone, the Library will host a special ribbon-cutting ceremony at noon on the 25th, officially opening the doors for Sunday service. Following the ceremony, the community is invited to join us for a day filled with engaging activities for all ages. The celebration will feature movies, crafts, music, and discovery, offering a taste of the enriching experiences the Library provides year-round.
