WINTER PARK, FL — September 8, 2026 — Solana Fine Art announces *Chromatic Journeys*, a vibrant two-person exhibition featuring artists Ana Guzmán and Victor Bokas, on view September 11 through October 16, 2026. An opening reception will be held Friday, September 11, from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. at the gallery in Winter Park.

Chromatic Journeys explores the expressive power of color, memory, and cultural identity, bringing together two artists whose distinctive approaches offer a compelling look at the ways personal history, heritage, and place can shape artistic expression.

“Ana and Victor approach their work from very different perspectives, but both understand the power of color to communicate something deeper than what we see on the surface,” said Bob Jimenez, founder & gallerist of Solana Fine Art. “There’s a real sense of memory, identity, joy, and cultural influence running through this exhibition. It’s a wonderful reminder that art can connect us to where we come from while also inviting us to see the world in new ways.”

Guzmán creates luminous, richly textured works that honor lived experience in her native, Havana, Cuba. Her paintings are characterized by emotional warmth, rhythmic mark-making, and layered references to heritage and personal history. Her compositions invite viewers into moments shaped by family, memory, and a sense of place.

Bokas, a native Floridian and central Florida favorite, brings a spirited counterpoint through vibrant graphic patterns, playful symbolism, and imaginative scenes. Drawing inspiration from his background and Florida’s whimsical landscape, his work celebrates identity, humor, curiosity, and the joy of discovery.

With cultural heritage serving as an important thread throughout the work—*Chromatic Journeys* offers a fitting opportunity to celebrate the richness, diversity, and creativity that shapes our shared experiences.

“Color has a remarkable ability to cross boundaries,” Jimenez added. “It can evoke a memory, communicate a feeling, connect us to a culture, or simply make us stop and look. That makes *Chromatic Journeys* an especially meaningful exhibition for this time of year.”
