**Solana Fine Art Presents *The Language of Light*

**Winter Park, FL, January 30, 2026** — Solana Fine Art invites the community to experience *The Language of Light*, an evocative exhibition exploring how light—physical, emotional, and metaphorical—reveals beauty in the everyday. On view February 3 through March 13, 2026, the exhibition brings together the work of **Stacy Barter** and **Ginger Oglesby**, two artists whose practices illuminate the quiet poetry of observation.

In a season often associated with emotion, reflection, and intimacy, *The Language of Light* offers viewers a space to slow down and look more closely—at gesture, atmosphere, memory, and the subtle radiance that lives within ordinary moments.

**Stacy Barter** presents luminous florals and figurative works marked by tenderness, clarity, and remarkable technical finesse. Her paintings capture the ephemeral: a fleeting gesture, a bloom turning toward the sun, the glow that exists in a moment we might otherwise overlook. Through realism that feels both delicate and grounded, Barter reveals light as a living presence—something felt as much as seen.

In contrast, **Ginger Oglesby** brings expressive narrative paintings layered with gesture, color, and deeply personal symbolism. Her compositions unfold like emotional landscapes, inviting viewers into interior worlds shaped by memory, intuition, and lived experience. Oglesby's use of light is atmospheric and psychological, guiding the viewer through spaces of reflection and resonance.

Together, Barter and Oglesby create a compelling dialogue between precision and spontaneity, observation, and interpretation. Their combined works explore how light becomes a language—one that communicates feeling, presence, and connection beyond words.

"This exhibition is about more than illumination in the visual sense," says Bob Jimenez, founder and gallerist of Solana Fine Art. "Stacy and Ginger each use light as a way to express something deeply human—tenderness, memory, emotion. Their work reminds us that beauty often exists in the quietest moments, if we allow ourselves to notice."
