“Art in Chambers” exhibition featuring the works of Dorothy Gillespie and John Nadeau

WINTER PARK, FL, an internationally-recognized, award winning city with multiple accredited agencies (August 14, 2019) – The City of Winter Park announces the newest “Art in Chambers” exhibitions featuring “Landscape Memory,” a Dorothy Gillespie sculpture, and “Winter Park After Dark,” science fiction-themed oil paintings and prints by John Nadeau. “Art in Chambers” is open for public viewing from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, except for holidays. Nadeau’s work will be on display for several months in the Chapman Room, while Gillespie’s sculpture will be on display for the next year in the Commission Chambers.

Dorothy Gillespie’s works include abstract expressionism, decorative abstraction, and site-specific installations. She worked in the women’s artist movement, art in public spaces, and was a pioneer in the new directions of metal sculpture. Gillespie is best known for large-scale, highly-colorful painted arrangements of cut aluminum strips radiating, undulating or curling in giant arrangements of ribbon, enchanted towers, and even the burst of fireworks.

John Nadeau has an extensive career creating original artworks for graphic novel publishers including AC Comics®, Dark Horse Comics®, DC Comics and Marvel. He has also worked in architectural rendering, media and television. Nadeau is currently working on an original sci-fi graphic novel that will be released soon, as well as oil paintings for The Art of Disney® galleries.

“Art in Chambers,” a project of the Winter Park Public Art Advisory Board, showcases works by Florida artists. “Art in Chambers” enlivens Winter Park’s public rooms and exposes residents and visitors to art, highlights the importance the city places on art and culture, provides city support to local artists and studios, and creates opportunities to educate the populace on the value of art and its places in a meaningful life.
