#### CITY OF WINTER PARK EMERGENCY CENTER

- The city's Emergency Operations Center is at Level 3 – Monitoring, and will move to a higher level depending on the track of the storm.
- All city departments are fully staffed with additional crews on stand-by to assist in preparation, recovery and restoration efforts.

#### SANDBAGS

- The last sandbag distribution opportunity will be Saturday, August 31, from 8 a.m. to noon (while supplies last).
- LOCATION: Ward Park & Showalter Stadium Parking Lot (288 Perth Lane). Enter site via Perth Lane and exit site via Cady Way.
- Limit eight bags per resident or business owner within the city limits.
- Please bring proof of residency - driver's license, valid ID or utility bill statement
- This sandbag distribution is a Fill-It-Yourself model. If you are physically unable, city staff will be available to assist those in need.

#### POWER OUTAGE MAP

- A live power outage map is posted at [cityofwinterpark.org/emergency](http://cityofwinterpark.org/emergency)
- If a red dot appears on your parcel, the city is aware of the outage – no need to call.
- If the map does not accurately reflect your current power status, please report the issue to [1-877-811-8700](tel:1-877-811-8700).
- The data for this map is collected by our automatic-meter reading system and relies on the integrity of the system. Our plan is to keep the map live throughout the duration of the storm and during our recovery period. If our meter reading system is compromised by the impacts of Hurricane Dorian, the map may be disabled.
- During a major storm and especially if a curfew is enacted, please stay indoors. There may be downed lines that are still energized and can cause serious injury and possible death.

#### WASTE PRO®

- There will be no recycling collection on Monday, September 2. Currently, garbage will be collected, however, updates to this will be posted under "Updates" on [cityofwinterpark.org/emergency](http://cityofwinterpark.org/emergency).
- Please do not place your items at the curb as they can become dangerous projectiles.
