City celebrated Winter Park Library & Events Center official Topping Out Ceremony



winter Park, FL, an internationally recognized, award winning city with multiple accredited agencies (October 30, 2020) The City of Winter Park and partners celebrated an important milestone in the construction of its state-of-the-art, 21st century Winter Park Library & Events Center, led by Adjaye Associates as design architect with HuntonBrady as executive architect. The official Topping Out Ceremony was held October 30, at 10:30 a.m., at the construction site located at 1052 W. Morse Blvd.

Sir David Adjaye OBE – founder of Adjaye Associates, lead designer of the Smithsonian National Museum of African American History & Culture, and recent recipient of the 2021 Royal Institute of British Arts (RIBA) Gold Medal, shared, "Today's topping out ceremony represents a huge milestone in the completion of the Winter Park Library & Events Center. The power of this project is that it represents another prototype, another version of what the library has evolved into—the library as a campus of knowledge. Once completed, the new complex will bring together knowledge and community facilities to make a village, a hamlet of knowledge."
