STATE OF FLORIDA EXECUTIVE ORDER 20-112

On April 30, Governor Ron DeSantis issued Executive Order #20-112 that outlined Phase 1: Safe. Smart. Step-by-Step. Plan for Florida's Recovery. This plan includes:

- Schools remain distance learning.
- Restaurants may offer outdoor seating with six foot space between tables and indoor seating at 25% capacity.
- Retail can operate at 25% of indoor capacity.
- No change for bars, gyms and personal services such as hair dressers.
- Avoid socializing in groups of more than 10 people in circumstances that do not readily allow for physical distancing.
- Face masks are recommended for all those in face-to-face interactions and where you can't social distance.

RE-OPENING OF WINTER PARK RESTAURANTS & RETAIL BUSINESSES

Adhering to Governor DeSantis' Executive Order, businesses will be required to function within their current permitted indoor and outdoor spaces.

Staying in compliance with the Executive Order, the city is planning a special restaurant and retail experience in celebration of Mother's Day weekend. Park Avenue will be closed at 4 p.m., on Friday, May 8, and remain closed all day Saturday and Sunday. More details will be available next week.

WINTER PARK GOLF COURSE REOPENS

The Winter Park Golf Course WP9 will reopen for public play beginning Monday, May 4. Please access cityofwinterpark.org/golf for specific guidelines and further details. All other city facilities remain closed to the public until further notice.

FREE WI-FI IN CENTRAL PARK

This weekend, the city, in partnership with local business Frog, will launch a FREE Wi-Fi service in and around the city's downtown business district. This public W-Fi service is already active in Central Park and will be fully functional in Shady Park by the end of next week.
