CITY OF WINTER PARK EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CENTER

- The city's Emergency Operations Center (EOC) is at Level 2 – Partial Activation, and will transition to Level 1 – Full Activation, Wednesday, September 28 at 9 a.m.
- All city departments are fully staffed with additional crews on stand-by to assist in preparation, recovery and restoration efforts.

SANDBAGS – while supplies last

- Sandbags are available today, Tuesday, September 27, until 3 p.m.
- LOCATION: Ward Park & Showalter Stadium Parking Lot (288 Perth Lane). Enter site via Perth Lane and exit site via Cady Way.
- Limit eight bags per resident or business owner within the city limits.
- Please bring proof of residency - driver's license, valid ID or utility bill statement.
- This sandbag pick-up is a Fill-It-Yourself model. If you are physically unable, city staff will be available to assist those in need.

CITY HALL & PUBLIC MEETINGS

- City Hall and all administrative offices will be closed Wednesday, September 28, and Thursday, September 29.
- The City Commission meeting scheduled for Wednesday, September 28, has been rescheduled for Thursday, October 6, at 5 p.m. Only time-sensitive agenda items will be heard on October 6.
- All advisory board meetings scheduled September 28-30 have been canceled.

PARKS & RECREATION

- All city parks and outdoor venues will be closed effective Tuesday, September 27, at sundown, through Thursday, September 29.
- All indoor recreation facilities will close Tuesday, September 27, at 6 p.m., and remain closed through Thursday, September 29.

 - Get Hooked Family Fishing Event (originally scheduled for Saturday, October 1)

WASTE PRO®
