Thursday, September 29, 2022 @ 9:30 a.m.

#### **CURFEW FOR THE CITY OF WINTER PARK**

- The City of Winter Park is issuing a curfew within city limits due to extensive flooding and tree debris making local roadways impassable.
- This curfew is effective until 5 p.m. today, and may be extended pending conditions of the roads.
- During a curfew, driving is prohibited with exception to emergency personnel and those essential employees traveling to and from work.
- Please stay indoors as conditions are still dangerous [live power lines may be down that are still energized and can cause serious injury and possible death; storm debris scattered about; weakened tree limbs; etc.].
- Please do not place debris on the curb during this time.

#### **NON-EMERGENCY CALL CENTER**

- The Call Center is staffed 24-7 today, Thursday, September 29.
- A determination will be made as the storm progresses for Call Center hours on Friday.

#### **LIVE POWER OUTAGE MAP**

- A live power outage map is posted at [cityofwinterpark.org/hurricanes](http://cityofwinterpark.org/hurricanes).
- If red lightning bolts appear in your neighborhood, the city is aware of the outage, there is no need to call.
- The data for this map is collected by our automatic-meter reading system and relies on the integrity of the system. If our meter reading system is compromised by the impacts of Hurricane Ian, the map may be disabled.
- Once conditions improve, electric crews will begin the restoration process.

#### **WASTE PRO®**

- Due to landfill closures, there will be NO garbage or recycling pickups the remainder of this week.
- Garbage, recycling and yard waste pickups will resume next week.
- Any items placed at the curb can become dangerous projectiles.

#### **CITY HALL & PUBLIC MEETINGS**

- City Hall and all administrative offices will be closed until Thursday, September 29.
- The City Commission meeting has been rescheduled for Thursday, October 6, at 5 p.m.
- All advisory board meetings scheduled September 28-30 have been canceled.

## **PARKS & RECREATION**

- All city parks, outdoor venues, and indoor recreation facilities are still closed.

## **GENERATOR SAFETY REMINDERS**

- Remember the 3 DON'Ts when using generators:
  1. DON'T run a generator in the house.
  2. DON'T run a generator in the garage.
  3. DON'T plug the generator directly into your home's main electrical system.
- DO run the generator outside in a well-ventilated area.
- DO plug individual appliances directly into the generator.
