CITY OF WINTER PARK EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CENTER

• The city's Emergency Operations Center (EOC) is at Level 1 – Full Activation

NON-EMERGENCY CALL CENTER

- The Call Center is staffed 24-7 Wednesday, September 28 and Thursday, September 29.
- A determination will be made as the storm progresses for Call Center hours on Friday.

LIVE POWER OUTAGE MAP

- A live power outage map is posted at <u>cityofwinterpark.org/hurricanes</u>.
- If a lightning bolt appears on your parcel, the city is aware of the outage no need to call.
- If the map does not accurately reflect your current power status, please report the issue to 1-877-811-8700.
- The data for this map is collected by our automatic-meter reading system and relies on the integrity of the system. If our meter reading system is compromised by the impacts of Hurricane Ian, the map may be disabled.
- During a major storm and especially if a curfew is enacted, please stay indoors. There may be downed lines that are still energized and can cause serious injury and possible death.

WASTE PRO®

- Due to landfill closures, there will be NO garbage or recycling pickups the remainder of this week.
- Garbage, recycling and yard waste pickups will resume next week.
- Any items placed at the curb can become dangerous projectiles. If you have carts at the curb, please store your items in a safe place throughout the duration of the storm.

CITY HALL & PUBLIC MEETINGS

- City Hall and all administrative offices will be closed until Thursday, September 29.
- The City Commission meeting scheduled for Wednesday, September 28, has been rescheduled for Thursday, October 6, at 5 p.m. Only time-sensitive agenda items will be heard on October 6.
- All advisory board meetings scheduled September 28-30 have been canceled.

PARKS & RECREATION

 All city parks, outdoor venues, and indoor recreation facilities will be closed through Thursday, September 29.

GENERATOR SAFETY REMINDERS

- Remember the 3 DON'Ts when using generators:
 - 1. DON'T run a generator in the house.
 - 2. DON'T run a generator in the garage.
 - 3. DON'T plug the generator directly into your home's main electrical system.
- DO run the generator outside in a well-ventilated area.
- DO plug individual appliances directly into the generator.
