CITY OF WINTER PARK EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CENTER (EOC)

- At 5 p.m., Thursday, November 10, the EOC will be transitioning to Level 3 Monitoring.
- The Non-Emergency Call Center at <u>407-599-3494</u> and email <u>messagecenter@cityofwinterpark.org</u> will remain operational until 5 p.m., Thursday, November 10.

POWER OUTAGES

• As of 12:15 p.m., there were approximately 105 outages. The peak number of outages reached during the storm was approximately 300.

TREES

• Approximately 10 tree failures were reported during the storm.

LAKE CLOSURES

• Due to elevated lake levels, **all lakes are closed** until further notice.

PARKS & RECREATION

- All city parks and facilities (indoor and outdoor) remain closed all day Thursday, November 10.
- A majority of city parks and facilities are expected to reopen on Friday, November 11.
- Dinky Dock and Lake Baldwin parks will be closed until further notice.
- The WP9 and Winter Park Pines golf courses are expected to reopen Friday, November 11, at noon, walking only no carts.

CITY HALL & PUBLIC MEETINGS

- City Hall and all administrative offices will reopen Friday, November 11.
- The Former Public Library Property Proposed Plans Public Meeting scheduled for Thursday, November 10, has been rescheduled for Thursday, November 17, at 5 p.m.

WASTE PRO®

- Fall Cleanup scheduled for households south of Fairbanks/Aloma avenues Thursday, November 10, or Friday, November 11, has been postponed. New dates will be scheduled after the storm.
- Garbage and recycling pickup that was scheduled for Thursday, November 10, will be rescheduled for Saturday, November 12.

LIMIT WATER USAGE

Because our water and wastewater systems and grounds were already saturated from Hurricane Ian and we received new rainfall from Tropical Storm Nicole, the city is encouraging residents to limit water usage by:

- Limiting the amount of toilet flushing.
- Abstaining from running dishwashers and clothes washers.
- Limiting the amount of water used during a shower or the amount to fill the bathtub.
- Turning off your irrigation.
- Abstaining from pressure washing, car washing, or any other outdoor use of water that is not necessary.
