CITY OF WINTER PARK EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CENTER (EOC)

- The EOC is currently at Level 3 Monitoring and will transition to Full Activation Level 1 Wednesday, November 9, at 7 p.m.
- All city departments are fully staffed with additional crews on stand-by to assist in preparation, recovery and restoration efforts.

FLOODING

For the areas that flooded during Hurricane Ian, due to highly saturated ground levels and highwater levels in the city's sanitary sewer system, expect flooding during Tropical Storm Nicole. Please prepare your households appropriately.

SANDBAGS - WHILE SUPPLIES LAST

- Sandbags are available today, Tuesday, November 8, until 6 p.m.
- Ward Park & Showalter Stadium Parking Lot (288 Perth Lane). Enter site via Perth Lane and exit via Cady Way.
- Limit eight bags per resident or business owner within the city limits.
- Please bring proof of residency: driver's license, valid ID or utility bill statement.
- This sandbag pickup is a Fill-It-Yourself model. If residents are physically unable to fill the bags, city staff will be available to assist those in need.

CITY HALL & PUBLIC MEETINGS

- City Hall and all administrative offices will be closed Thursday, November 10, and pending storm conditions, will re-open Friday, November 11.
- The City Commission meeting for Wednesday, November 9, is still scheduled, however, the <u>agenda</u> has been modified and truncated to allow for safe travels home.
- The City Commission work session scheduled for Thursday, November 10, is cancelled.
- The Former Public Library Property Proposed Plans Public Meeting scheduled for Thursday, November 10, has been rescheduled for Thursday, November 17, at 5 p.m.

LIMIT WATER USAGE

Because our water and wastewater systems and grounds are still saturated from Hurricane Ian, the city is encouraging residents to limit water usage by:

- Limiting the amount of toilet flushing.
- Abstaining from running dishwashers and clothes washers.
- Limiting the amount of water used during a shower or the amount to fill the bathtub.
- Turning off your irrigation.
- Abstaining from pressure washing, car washing, or any other outdoor use of water that is not necessary.
