Winter Park asks residents to recycle election signs

WINTER PARK, FL, an internationally recognized, award winning city with multiple accredited agencies (March 2, 2022) The City of Winter Park's Sustainability Program is partnering with the [League of Women Voters of Orange County Natural Resources Committee](#) to recycle election signs generated from this year's upcoming election.

Winter Park residents are encouraged to bring their signs and stands beginning **Monday, March 7, at noon, through Monday, March 21, to Fire Station 64** located at 1439 Howell Branch Road.

This recycling initiative will prevent an abundance of yard signs from going to a local landfill. Instead, the signs will be transported to [NuCycle Energy](#) where they will be transformed from bulky discarded plastic to NuCycle's Enviro Fuelcubes. The Fuelcubes are then sold to [Cemex](#), a large regional cement manufacturer, where they are used to generate electricity, replacing coal as a cleaner energy source.

This partnership with the league was first initiated during the November 2020 campaign season. At the conclusion of the drive, over 10,000 signs (two tons) were successfully recycled in Winter Park instead of being disposed in a local landfill.
