Winter Park calls for Green Schools Grant applicants

WINTER PARK, FL, an internationally recognized, award winning city with multiple accredited agencies (October 28, 2022) The Natural Resources & Sustainability Department's Sustainability Division and Keep Winter Park Beautiful are calling all Pre-K through grade 12 public and private schools to apply for Green Schools Grants by Friday, December 30, at 5 p.m. Green Schools Grants support schools serving Winter Park in their efforts to achieve sustainability goals and beautify their campus while engaging and educating students in the practices of sustainability.

The intent of the Green Schools Grant Program is to fund projects that will support the objectives of the Winter Park Sustainability Action Plan (SAP) focusing on one or more of the following SAP categories:

- Buildings, Energy & Water
- Community Engagement & Green Economy
- Local Food & Agriculture
- Mobility & Urban Form
- Natural Systems & Resources
- Waste Diversion & Recycling



Pre-K through grade 12 schools, public and private, serving students who live in Winter Park are considered eligible. Colleges and universities within city limits are also eligible. Grant recipients will be chosen by the Keep Winter Park Beautiful & Sustainable Advisory Board.
