The heritage festival begins on **Sunday, January 15,** from **1 to 5 p.m.**, in <u>Shady Park</u> at Hannibal Square, located at the intersection of Pennsylvania and New England avenues. Sunday's entertainment will feature various gospel artists, along with mime and praise dance performances. The center pays tribute to the past, present and future contributions of Winter Park's historic African-American community.

The festival continues in Shady Park **Monday, January 16**, **Martin Luther King, Jr. Day,** from **11 a.m. to 5 p.m.** Winter Park city officials and community leaders will join in the day's impactful activities. These include a Martin Luther King, Jr. symbolic program at 11 a.m., the presentation of the Heritage Award, kids' activities, food & retail vendors, career booths, job training/health literacy assistance, Zoo Mom Science, and blues & jazz bands featuring Brenda White and Jabari Clay.
