City seeks grant to rebuild boardwalks at Mead Botanical Garden

WINTER PARK, FL, an internationally recognized, award winning city with multiple accredited agencies (January 30, 2023) The city's Parks & Recreation Department will host a public meeting on Tuesday, February 7, at 5 p.m., at the Winter Park Community Center located at 721 West New England Avenue. The city is applying for a Florida Department of Environmental Protection Recreational Trails Program grant to rebuild the boardwalks at Mead Botanical Garden. Attendees will learn more about the grant and have the opportunity to provide input for inclusion in the application process.

Mead Botanical Garden is a 48-acre urban oasis that offers many paths and trails through forested wetlands, under longleaf pine canopies, and within unique wildlife habitats. The grant offers a potential funding of up to \$500,000 for selected projects and as part of the grant process, the input gathered from this public forum will help build a stronger application for consideration.
