## Household hazardous waste and e-waste dropoff for residents

**WINTER PARK, FL, an internationally recognized, award winning city with multiple accredited agencies (February 13, 2023)** The city's [Sustainability Division](#) will present a [Household Hazardous Waste Dropoff](#) **Saturday, March 4, from 8 a.m. to noon**, at Orange and Cypress avenues. As shown in the attached map, patrons of the dropoff should enter Palmetto Avenue from Harmon or Cypress avenues.

Hazardous waste items accepted include: (service provided by Waste Pro®)

- fertilizers & pesticides
- household chemicals
- antifreeze
- tires (4 max.)
- paint thinners
- wet latex paint (dried can be disposed of with your regular household trash)
- pool chemicals
- gasoline
- used engine oil
- propane tanks
- oil-based paint (wet or dry)
- non-alkaline batteries (regular alkaline batteries can be disposed of in your regular household trash)

E-waste items include: (service provided by A1 Assets, Inc.)

- computers
- VCRs
- stereos & CD players
- televisions
- DVD players
- FAX machines

Helpful tips

- Bring proof of city residency (driver's license or utility bill statement).
- Keep all hazardous waste materials in original containers with original labeling (unknown items will NOT be accepted).
- This drop off is residential only. No contractors, please.
- Prescription meds go to the Public Safety Facility (500 N. Virginia Ave., 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday).

### Please Note:

The following streets will be impacted from 7 a.m. to 1 p.m.

- **Palmetto Avenue** will be one-way traffic only.
- **Orange and Minnesota avenues** may experience some traffic congestion.
