The community is invited to the Sustainability Fair & EV Car Show

(August 18, 2023) In recognition of National Drive Electric Week, the city's Natural Resources & Sustainability Department will present its second Sustainability Fair & EV Car Show, Saturday, September 23, from 9 to 11 a.m., in Central Park West Meadow located at 150 W. Morse Blvd., adjacent to the United States Post

Office. City officials will share remarks at 9:30 a.m. Event sponsors include Audi North Orlando, Genesis North Orlando and Holler Hyundai.

In addition to electric bicycles, motorcycles and over 30 vehicles on display, the event will feature an array of sustainability vendors such as Electrification Coalition, League of Women Voters of Orange County, New Life Ebike Co., Winter Park Library, and Zenyge. To help everyone stay cool as they learn about current sustainability best practices, FREE Kona Ice[®] will be offered in all their delicious flavors.

Orange County Public Schools (OCPS) will display one of their six new electric school busses, which were purchased in part by a Florida Department of Environmental Protection grant. The electric bus pilot program began last February and will allow OCPS, the first district in Florida to put electric busses on the road, to evaluate cost-savings data related to not purchasing diesel fuel nor needing to provide oil and filter changes, all while reducing air pollutants.

The Natural Resources & Sustainability Department is responsible for the overall operation and management of sustainability as well as management and regulation compliance for the city's lakes.
