## Winter Park storm information

### YARD DEBRIS FINAL UPDATE

Friday, November 8, 2024

As of November 7, all special collections for vegetative debris have concluded. Vegetative debris must follow the normal requirements for pick up and is subject to code violation if debris is not properly disposed of:

- All yard waste must be containerized. Yard waste containers are not provided. Please place yard waste in large paper bags or reusable carts that can be purchased from local hardware stores. Blue recycling containers should not be used for excess yard waste.
- If yard waste is unable to be containerized, it will only be collected if it is tied stacked and bundled, does not exceed four (4) feet in length (except palm fronds) or four (4) inches in radius, nor be greater than 50 pounds in weight for any piece or segment of such materials. Palm fronds stacked curbside shall be collected whole.
- Yard waste in excess of three (3) cubic yards shall be assessed an extra charge.
- Residential property may not be used for open storage of vehicle parts, appliances, building materials, garbage, waste, trash or debris. [Ch. 22, Sec. 302.1]
