Registration is now open for Parks & Recreation Summer Camp

WINTER PARK, FL, an internationally recognized, award winning city with multiple accredited agencies (April 16, 2024) The city's Parks & Recreation Department Summer Camp begins Tuesday, May 28, through Friday, August 9, and spots are filling up quickly. Families can register now at the Winter Park Community Center located at 721 W. New England Ave. Registration will remain open until the camp is full.

When registering, please bring the following:

- proof of residency (City of Winter Park residents)
- participant's birth certificate and current report card
- one-time registration fee
- full payment for all weeks reserved

The following summer camps and program at the Community Center will be offered Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m.:

Summer Fun Camp (entering kindergarten* through grade 5)

* Participants MUST be 5 years old on or before May 28, 2024, and entering kindergarten to enroll.

Registration (one-time fee): \$25 per child
Resident: \$85 per week (\$60 each additional child)
Non-resident: \$110 per week (\$85 each additional child)

Middle School Camp (entering grades 6-8)

Registration (one-time fee): \$25 per child
Resident: \$60 per week (\$40 each additional child)
Non-resident: \$90 per week (\$70 each additional child)

Junior Counselor Volunteer Program (entering grades 9-12)

Mission: to provide opportunities for teens in the community to grow as future leaders. Teens will learn valuable work experience and become positive role models for campers. They will also receive community service hours that can be used to fulfill their high school requirement.
