City to hold Annual 4th of July Celebration

WINTER PARK, FL (June 13, 2025) - The City of Winter Park invites you to attend the 30th Annual 4th of July Celebration which will be held on Friday, July 4, from 8:30 to 11 a.m., in Central Park and the West Meadow. The event is free and open to the public. Bring your blankets and lawn chairs, and wear your red, white and blue to enjoy a morning of patriotic celebration.

The festivities begin at the main stage with opening remarks from Mayor Sheila DeCiccio along with the National Anthem. The event continues with music from the School of Rock® Winter Park and a patriotic performance by the Bach Festival Choir and Brass Ensemble led by Dr. John Sinclair. Activities will also feature a Kids Zone in the West Meadow with carnival midway games, bounce slides, face painters, Kona Ice® and more, all hosted by the Parks & Recreation Department. The annual bicycle parade will begin at 9:30 a.m. Children can bring their bicycles already decorated or decorate them at the corner of Park Avenue and Morse Boulevard. Winter Park Electric will sponsor FREE individual mini pies, cookies and water (while supplies last).

In conjunction with city festivities, The Charles Hosmer Morse Museum of American Art will celebrate 30 years on Park Avenue with its Independence Day Celebration. The museum, which is home to the world's most comprehensive collection of work by American artist Louis Comfort Tiffany, will provide FREE admission to its galleries from 9:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. with live music from 1 to 4 p.m. Also, in downtown Winter Park, the Winter Park History Museum, located at 200 W. New England Ave. (north end of the historic Farmers' Market building), will be open with FREE admission from 9 a.m. to noon.

Please note that City Hall will be closed Friday, July 4, in observance of Independence Day. City offices will reopen at 8 a.m. Monday, July 7.
