Natural Resources & Sustainability Department announces next "FIX IT! DON'T Pitch It"

WINTER PARK, FL (August 22, 2025) "Fix It! Don't Pitch It," initiated by the City of Winter Park and Winter Park Library, is a community repair workshop in partnership with Orange County. Winter Park will host their next "Fix It! Don't Pitch It" workshop Saturday, September 6, from 9 a.m. to noon, at the Winter Park Community Center located at 721 W. New England Avenue.

At this workshop, skilled volunteer fixers offer free minor repairs for gently used household items such as electronics, bicycles, small appliances, jewelry, eyeglasses, watches, clothing and other textiles. The workshop is designed to support the city's Sustainability Action Plan by extending the life of everyday items, reducing waste, and promoting recycling. Participants can save money by repairing rather than replacing, while also learning valuable repair skills and connecting with knowledgeable volunteers from the community.

Please bring electronics fully charged as well as any parts that may be required to fix the item. There will be a limit of two items per person. Services are subject to change.
