WINTER PARK, FL (August 21, 2025) – On Monday, August 25, at 9 a.m., the City of Winter Park and community partners will be celebrating the official dedication of the first of two newly installed historic gateways to downtown Winter Park. A second gateway will be installed on the south end of Park Avenue in late September. These two gateways were designed to honor downtown Winter Park's heritage and historic significance. In 2011, the Downtown Winter Park Historic District, was added to the National Register of Historic Places, the official listing of historically significant sites and properties throughout the country.
