WINTER PARK, FL (July 14, 2025) – On Thursday, July 17, at 9 a.m., the City of Winter Park's Natural Resources & Sustainability Department, city officials and community partners will be celebrating the energizing of the city's first official Mobility Hub. This public/private partnership features seven fast chargers from a collaboration with Charge Point, Optimus Energy Solutions and GM Energy.

The Mobility Hub offers residents and guests the ability to fully charge any electric vehicle while they enjoy premier shopping and dining on Park Avenue and surrounding districts. It also features a special location for rideshare pickup/drop off and will soon provide two chargers for electric scooters and bikes, so residents have the option to leave their cars at home. Although eScooters and eBikes are prohibited on Park Avenue, enjoyment of these types of electric vehicles are encouraged on streets adjacent to the commercial district.

The Winter Park Mobility Hub will help support the city's increasing electric vehicle adoption rate and sustainability goals. Given its close location to the Winter Park Train Station and SunRail, it provides residents and guests greater options as they select their desired mode of transportation when traveling to downtown Winter Park.
