Summer Camp Registration opens Monday for Winter Park residents

WINTER PARK, FL (March 13, 2025) The city's Parks & Recreation Department Summer Camp begins Monday, June 2, through Friday, August 8. Families can register at the Winter Park Community Center located at 721 W. New England Ave. Registration opens Monday, March 17, for residents and Monday, March 31, for non-residents. Registration will remain open until the camp is full.

Please bring the following items for registration:

- proof of residency (City of Winter Park residents)
- participant's birth certificate
- current report card
- one-time registration fee
- full payment for all weeks reserved

The following camps and program at the Community Center will be offered Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m.:

Summer Fun Camp (entering kindergarten* through grade 5)

* Participants MUST be 5 years old on or before May 28, 2024, and entering kindergarten to enroll.

Registration (one-time fee): \$25 per child
Resident: \$90 per week (\$60 each additional child)
Non-resident: \$120 per week (\$85 each additional child)

Middle School Camp (entering grades 6-8)

Registration (one-time fee): \$25 per child
Resident: \$60 per week (\$40 each additional child)
Non-resident: \$90 per week (\$70 each additional child)

Junior Counselor Volunteer Program (entering grades 9-12)

Mission: to provide opportunities for teens in the community to grow as future leaders. Teens will learn valuable work experience and become positive role models for campers. They will also receive community service hours that can be used to fulfill their high school requirement.
