## City reminds residents to participate in survey and final Parks & Recreation Master Plan community meeting

**WINTER PARK, FL (May 8, 2026)** As of March 27, the city's [Parks & Recreation Department](#) began conducting an online citywide survey to gather resident input on a variety of topics to help guide upcoming strategic planning decisions and the development of a master plan. Winter Park residents will be able to access a 10-minute survey at [planwinterparkparks.com](http://planwinterparkparks.com) until **Sunday, May 31**.

This important survey will help guide how parks, open spaces, recreation programs, and facilities are planned, developed and improved over the next decade. It will also help the city better understand community priorities and prepare for potential changes in state tax policy that may affect how the city funds future services. Residents will be asked questions regarding the types of improvements they want and what they would like to prioritize. Survey results will help create a priority blueprint for places in need of improvement, methods for growing responsibly, as well as programs and recreational opportunities the Winter Park community would like to see implemented.

An additional way to remain involved in the Parks & Recreation Master Plan process includes attending interactive community workshops. The final workshop will be held on **Tuesday, May 12**, from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m., at the Winter Park Community Center, located at 721 W. New England Ave.
