## **CITY OF WINTER PARK RECEIVES WATER TREATMENT PLANT AWARD**

**WINTER PARK, Fla., a nationally recognized Silver Circle Award and National Merit Award winner (May 16, 2007)** – The Florida Section American Water Works Association (FSAWWA) has awarded the City of Winter Park the “2007 Class C Water Treatment Plant Award” for the Magnolia Water Treatment Plant. Class C treatment plants include those that treat up to 10 million gallons of water per day. The award was presented to the City of Winter Park at the joint annual Water Environment Federation / FSAWWA.

Criteria evaluated by the selection committee included regulatory compliance, operational safety, facility maintenance, operational efficiency, and water quality. According to David Zusi, Water & Wastewater Utility Director, “We have received several state and national awards for our new state-of-the-art facilities. However, we are especially proud to have received this award which recognizes our quality of operational excellence.”
