WINTER PARK, Fla., *an internationally recognized ICMA Excellence Award winner with accredited fire-rescue, police and parks & recreation agencies (March 5, 2019)* – The City of Winter Park will proudly host “Earth Day/Arbor Day in the Park” **Saturday, April 13**. This fun-filled event, presented by the City of Winter Park’s Sustainability Program and Keep Winter Park Beautiful (KWPB), will be held from **11 a.m. to 3 p.m.**, in Shady Park located adjacent to the Winter Park Community Center at 721 W. New England Ave. Ceremonial events from the Ruby Ball Amphitheater will include Winter Park Green School Grant awards and KWPB sponsor recognitions.

“Earth Day/Arbor Day in the Park” will provide fun for all ages including a **kid’s zone** with the Winter Park Public Library Book Bike, make and takes, games, art projects and tie-dye t-shirts; **live music** all day long; green organizations and city sustainability-related **information booths**; child and adult **yoga**; **recycling information, bike rodeo** with helmet fitting, safety checks and obstacle course for ages five years old and up; **electric vehicle car show, beer and wine garden, used shoe collection with Shoes4Kids**, as well as **live cooking demonstrations, art demonstrations, story time for kids** in the adjacent community center, and much more!

In celebration of Arbor Day, certified arborists from the city’s Urban Forestry Division will be on-site to answer questions and give away an assortment of one-gallon containerized trees for city residents to plant at home.

Founded by U.S. Senator Gaylord Nelson in 1970, Earth Day is designed to inspire awareness and appreciation for the earth’s environment. This celebration will showcase how the City of Winter Park and KWPB are working to make the city more sustainable.
