North American Occupational Safety and Health Week | May 1-7, 2016 and Occupational Safety and Health Professional Day | May 4, 2016

WHEREAS, the residents of Winter Park, Florida, value safe and healthful workplaces for all of our citizens; and

WHEREAS, the majority of workplace injuries and fatalities are preventable, however more than 4,600 workers die each year from job-related injuries, and millions more suffer occupational injuries and illnesses; and

WHEREAS, businesses spend \$62 billion a year on the costs of the most disabling workplace injuries tied to occupational injuries, health care and illnesses; and

WHEREAS, safer organizations enjoy increased productivity, higher employee satisfaction, and a better reputation, while recording less lost time, and as well as lower workers' compensation and healthcare costs; and


WHEREAS, during the week of Sunday, May 1, through Saturday, May 7, North American Occupational Safety and Health Week (NAOSH), the American Society of Safety Engineers members, the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA), and corporate/association partners representing thousands of businesses will mobilize in an effort to increase employer, employee and public awareness of being safe at work to encourage safe practices; as well as help companies and organizations enhance their workplace safety efforts; and
