Allen Trovillion Day | March 27, 2017

WHEREAS, Allen Trovillion served as Winter Park Mayor from 1962 through 1967; and

WHEREAS, in 1994, after retiring from a career as a general contractor, Trovillion was elected to the Florida House of Representatives where he served four consecutive terms through 2002; and

WHEREAS, he served in the United States Army Air Corps and is a World War II veteran; and

WHEREAS, Trovillion has been married to wife Vicki Pruitt Trovillion for 31 years, and has eight children and 13 grandchildren; and

WHEREAS, he has remained active in the central Florida community serving on boards and assisting organizations such as Associated Builders and Contractors, Economic Development Committee of Mid-Florida, Greater Orlando Chamber of Commerce, Rotary Club of Winter Park, Winter Park Chamber of Commerce, Boy Scouts of America®, Winter Park Jaycees, and Albin Polasek Museum & Sculpture Gardens, just to name a few; and

WHEREAS, the Winter Park community is grateful for Trovillion's dedication and commitment to the country, state of Florida, and City of Winter Park, and has therefore named the "front porch" of City Hall as Trovillion Porch in his honor.

NOW, THEREFORE, I Steve Leary, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Winter Park, in the state of Florida, do hereby proclaim **Monday, March 27, 2017**, as "**Allen Trovillion Day**" in Winter Park, Florida.
