**WHEREAS**, Barley has enthusiastically championed regionalism during his tenure, recognizing that a world-class transportation system must be seamless across city and county lines; and

**WHEREAS**, he has been an advocate for many regional transportation projects affecting Winter Park and central Florida, such as SunRail®, I-4 Ultimate Improvement Project®, and the I-4/St. Johns River Veterans Memorial Bridge; and

**WHEREAS**, Barley is a graduate of Crummer Graduate School of Business at Rollins College and has been a Winter Park resident for two decades and;

**WHEREAS**, he has joyfully served Winter Park in many capacities, including serving on the Transportation Advisory Board, Winter Park Health Foundation board, and Florida Hospital Board of Directors; and

**WHEREAS**, Barley has also served the community as a Governor's appointee on the Wekiva River Basin Commission, and through active involvement with the region's higher education institutions, help establish urban and regional planning programs at Rollins College and University of Central Florida.
