Carol Miller Rosenfelt Day | March 5, 2023

WHEREAS, on February 8, 2023, the City of Winter Park lost a bright light with the passing of Carol Miller Rosenfelt; and

WHEREAS, born and raised in Campton in Wolfe County, Kentucky, Carol graduated from Wolfe County High School in 1974, and earned a degree in Business Administration from Eastern Kentucky University where she was a member of Chi Omega Sorority; and

WHEREAS, she touched the lives of others wherever she went and made it her life's work to help her community, was active in the Junior League of Greater Orlando as a member and sustaining member, helping countless children and families through their programs and outreach, she was named Sustainer of the Year multiple times; and

WHEREAS, demonstrating her love of our city's people, history and heritage, Carol was a driving force behind the Winter Park History Museum, where her leadership skills came to the fore as a board member, board president and chair of the Sponsorship Committee for several Peacock Balls; and

WHEREAS, embracing civic responsibility, she was a graduate of Leadership Winter Park Class XXIV and always well informed, she studied the issues and educated and empowered others to do likewise, voting faithfully in local elections while respectfully encouraging and holding public officials accountable; and

WHEREAS, working tirelessly to protect what she valued, Carol served as a member and immediate past chair of the city's Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) Advisory Board, which makes recommendations regarding programs, funding, and land use and design regulations with the CRA boundaries, including our valued Central Park, Central Business District and historic Hannibal Square Neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, cherishing the natural beauty of Winter Park, Carol and her husband Bill, recently donated dozens of personally selected, hand-grafted camellias which now grace our city's Kraft Azalea Garden; and

WHEREAS, Carol Miller Rosenfelt was the embodiment of graciousness and hospitality who lived her life with a generous spirit and a full open heart.
