proclamation

Florida Climate Week | October 7-13, 2024

WHEREAS, Florida Climate Week focuses on climate resilience, clean energy initiatives, and the impact of climate change on Florida's communities, ecosystems, and economy; and

WHEREAS, Florida, with over 825 miles of coastline and many areas just a few feet above sea level, is highly vulnerable to the impacts of climate change, including sea-level rise, flooding, saltwater intrusion, and stronger, more frequent storms; and

WHEREAS, the VoLo Foundation and its collaborators are dedicated to educating residents and visitors of Florida about science-based climate solutions by empowering them with data-driven solutions to take action for a more resilient future; and

WHEREAS, climate-related changes such as ocean warming, acidification, and pollution pose severe threats to Florida's coral reefs, marine biodiversity, and fisheries, which are vital to the state's environmental health and economic prosperity; and

WHEREAS, residents are encouraged participate in the week-long educational programming available during Florida Climate Week by accessing Florida Climate Week.org and attending community engagement events in Winter Park; and

WHEREAS, collaboration is at the heart of effective climate action towards a sustainable and resilient Florida.
