

## Contactless tree giveaway presented by the city's Urban Forestry Division

The City of Winter Park's Urban Forestry Division will present a safe, socially-distanced, **Drive Up for the Trees** contactless tree giveaway on **Saturday, August 15, from 8 a.m. to noon**, outside the Winter Park Community Center located at 721 W. New England Ave.

A large assortment of one-gallon container trees in many varieties will be FREE to Winter Park residents who show a valid ID. Residents can simply drive up to the giveaway location and have their tree selection placed in their vehicle by city staff.

Winter Park residents are encouraged to participate in this tree giveaway to assist Urban Forestry, a division of the Parks & Recreation Department, in its mission to protect, preserve, enhance, and nurture Winter Park's urban forest. The city's Urban Forestry staff maintains existing vigorous trees, removes dead/diseased/dying trees, and replants with a diverse species selection in an effort to promote our most important renewable resource as well as sustain our forest for today and future generations.

Always remember to plant the right tree in the right place. Urban Forestry staff will be on site at the contactless tree giveaway to assist residents in their selections and offer best practices advice.
