Dear Neighbor:

As part of our continuing effort to provide excellent service and reliability, TECO Peoples Gas is upgrading our natural gas infrastructure. While we have already been working in your area during the day, I'm reaching out to inform you that overnight work is scheduled to start August 18 and is expected to be completed November 16.

I apologize in advance for any inconvenience this construction may cause. Please know that the safety of our customers, the general public, and our employees and contractors are the number one priority of Peoples Gas.

Because the project area covers busy streets, this work will occur overnight beginning at 9 p.m. and ending at 6 a.m., except on Friday and Saturday nights, per Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) requirements. The nature of this work involves the use of cutting tools, drills and construction vacuum trucks which can be noisy. In an effort to reduce disturbance to you, we are planning for the majority of the cutting work to happen during the daytime and early evening. However, you may hear other equipment during the night.
