**Road Closure Operation Narrative – City of Winter Park**

On **April 13<sup>th</sup>, 2026**, a temporary road closure will be implemented on **Knowles Avenue** between **New England Avenue and Lyman Avenue** within the City of Winter Park to facilitate **underground utility work and pavement remediation**. These activities will run through **May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026**, and will be opened fully following work shift on that day. All activities will be performed in accordance with the approved City of Winter Park right-of-way permit, Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) plan, and applicable local, state, and federal regulations.

Prior to initiating the closure, all required permits and approvals will be obtained from the City of Winter Park. Advance notification is being provided to affected residents, businesses, and emergency service providers as required. Traffic control devices, including advance warning signs, barricades, cones, and detour signage, will be installed by qualified personnel to safely direct vehicular and pedestrian traffic around the work area.

The closure will be actively monitored throughout the operation to ensure traffic control devices remain properly positioned, visible, and in good condition. Local access will be maintained where feasible, and pedestrian access will be provided in accordance with ADA requirements. Emergency vehicle access will be maintained at all times, with personnel available on site to immediately modify or remove traffic control devices if necessary.

Work activities will be confined to the approved limits and conducted within the authorized hours to minimize impacts to the public. The work zone will be inspected regularly to confirm continued compliance with the approved MOT plan and City of Winter Park safety standards.

Upon completion of the work, the roadway will be inspected to ensure it was free of debris and hazards. All traffic control devices will be removed, and the roadway fully restored and reopened to normal traffic operations.

The road closure operation will be completed safely, without incident, and in full compliance with City of Winter Park requirements.
