

The 2024 "Best of Show" piece, now on display in City Hall lobby, is a magnificent painting titled Matheson Hammock Park by Hernan Rodriguez. Born in 1982 Güines, Havana, Rodriguez is a self-taught contemporary landscape painter with humble beginnings in the countryside. Surrounded by unique and exotic landscapes, Rodriguez discovered early on that painting would be his lifelong passion. Using the landscape of his hometown in Cuba as the prime motive and model behind his works, the artist garnered the attention of Raul Perdomo, a renowned Cuban landscape painter, and eventually became his apprentice. He later travelled to Miami, where he currently lives and works.


