The **Public Art Advisory Board** implemented a new initiative two years ago, housing the current year’s Winter Park Sidewalk Art Festival “Best of Show” piece in the City Hall lobby for all visitors to enjoy. These pieces are then moved to a permanent home in City Hall, the Winter Park Library & Events Center or Welcome Center, becoming part of the entire public art collection and making way for the next Best of Show piece to be displayed.



The 2024 “Best of Show” piece, now on display in City Hall lobby, is a magnificent painting titled *Matheson Hammock Park* by [Hernan Rodriguez](#). Born in 1982 Güines, Havana, Rodriguez is a self-taught contemporary landscape painter with humble beginnings in the countryside. Surrounded by unique and exotic landscapes, Rodriguez discovered early on that painting would be his lifelong passion. Using the landscape of his hometown in Cuba as the prime motive and model behind his works, the artist garnered the attention of Raul Perdomo, a renowned Cuban landscape painter, and eventually became his apprentice. He later travelled to Miami, where he currently lives and works.
